St. Eustatius does not have a resident vet. SEAWF provides emergency services in support of the visiting vet from St. Maarten. We also conduct sterilization campaigns to reduce unwanted puppies and kittens. We have an education and advertising program to help inform Stations about proper treatment of the animals and provide local news about pet diseases or other animal related concerns.

VETERINARY APPOINTMENTS

Make an appointment by calling 318-4150. Dr. Swanston, the visiting veterinarian comes to Statia about every 2 weeks. See our website (www.seawf.com) for his schedule and prices.

ABOUT VACCINATIONS

There are a number of preventable dog and cat diseases found on Statia, including Canine Distemper, Parvo-virus, and Feline Leukemia. Some of these diseases arrived only recently on Statia. It is important now to get your pet vaccinated each year. Read more about this on our website.

ABOUT CANINE DISTEMPER

This is a virus in dogs that has no cure. You can only prevent it by getting your dog a shot called a vaccination. Most dogs that get the disease die of it. The disease spreads in dogs like the flu spreads in people. Initial symptoms: coughing, running nose & eyes, vomiting and diarrhea, fever, dehydration, drooling, loss of appetite, and weight loss. These symptoms may go away, but not the disease. Later symptoms include twitching, seizures, weak limbs, and even partial paralysis. See our website for more information.
